



ABOUT US

The International Association of Bleausardes (L'association Internationale Des Bleausardes registered in France with the number W774006209, referred to below as “we”, “us” or “the Association”) is a not-for-profit voluntary organisation.

Our goals, as stated in the official Status (available in French upon request), are as follows:

- To promote gender equality in the climbing community
- To encourage climbers who identify as female to develop their outdoor climbing skills
- To aid the conservation of the Fontainebleau Forest
- To organize social gatherings serving our other goals
- To facilitate mentorship relationships between climbers of various levels and ages
- To provide formal and informal instruction in sports such as the climbing, parkour and yoga
- To encourage experienced climbers to share their knowledge with the community and facilitate knowledge sharing through mentorship
- To facilitate cooperation between climbers and the governing bodies responsible for the protection of the Fontainebleau Forest

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These General Trade Terms and Conditions stipulate rights and duties between the Association and the purchaser using the services of the Association ("Participant") in regard to providing services stated below.

Contractual relationship between the Association and the Participant ("Contract") is created by online purchase via Eventbrite by crediting a full payment or a deposit of funds for services to Eventbrite.

By Services and/or Activities the Association means facilitating climbing and other sporting and/or social activities in light of the aforementioned goals of the Association.

1. Bookings and Reservations

The Participant can book the services through the Association's listings on Eventbrite.

2. Payment

The Participant is obliged to pay for the services the amount listed on Everbrite listing of the Association's events.

3. Risks & Liability Waiver

The Association is obliged to inform the Participants of the inherent risks of rock climbing and other activities organised by the Association. Clients are participating at their own risk and responsibility.

The Association strongly urges all Participants to purchase an appropriate travel and climbing insurance before attending the events organised by the Association.

A liability [waiver](#) must be signed but each participant or, in case of minors, their parent/guardian.

4. Responsibilities of the Association

The Association is responsible for carrying out Activities as advertised on the website. The Association facilitates knowledge sharing between Participants but does not provide formal guiding or instruction in outdoor climbing.

The Association is responsible for purchasing a civil liability insurance for all members of the Association that act as officers and volunteers in relation to the events organised by the Association.

5. Duty of Confidentiality

During the Activities organised by the Association and in connection with them, business practises and connections of the Association, know-how, etc. may be disclosed or revealed in any way to the Participants. The Participants agree and accept that such information is confidential and the Association is the sole and exclusive owner of this intellectual property and protected information. Disclosing of this type of information to any third party (especially to a direct competition) is strictly forbidden.

6. Participants' Personal Data

The Data Protection Policy of the Association is part of the general Terms & Conditions and can be accessed [here](#).

7. Prohibited Behaviour

Any behaviour that compromises the safety of Participants or members of the Association is not tolerated during the Activities organised by the Association. Persons engaging in such behaviour will be banned from participating in the Activities. The Association reserves the right to ban the Participant from continuing or starting activities should above mentioned situation arise. The Association can do so without monetary compensation to the Participant.

8. Health and Safety

In case of health complications or an accident, the Association ensures that a member of the Association holding valid first aid training certification is always present in area where the Activities are carried out. A first aid kit is made available at the disposal of trained members of the Association. In case of an emergency medical services can be called.

The Association has the right to terminate activities at any time if it is considered appropriate in order to ensure Participants health and safety.

9. Returns Policy

The Association is responsible for the provided services and activities to be of stipulated quality and to be carried out in accordance with the agreement. The services and activities must correspond to the description of the services.

Complaints regarding the services provided may be submitted in the course of the services being carried out. Hidden defects must be claimed immediately after the Participant learns about them. The defects must be claimed no later than six months after the services were provided.

In case the services or activities were not provided in accordance with the agreement, the Participant has right to rectification free of charge. In case the rectification is not possible, the Participant is entitled to a partial or full refund.

The return policy can be exercised by email, by post, or in person. The Association will send the Participant a written confirmation about receiving the notification from the Participant.

The starting moment of exercising the return policy is the moment the Association was notified about the occurrence of the defect.

The Association deals with received complaints immediately or at the latest within thirty days from the day of the exercising of the complaint.

In case of a disputable complaint, the Association will decide about its acceptance within three working days from the date of the exercising of the complaint.

The conditions for termination of contract and/or refund are as follows:

1. If the contract is terminated more than 30 days before the starting date of the Activity the Participant will be fully refunded.
2. In case the contract is terminated less than 30 days before the starting date of the Activity the Participant is not eligible for any refund.
3. In case of a sudden and unexpected incident (e.g. injury, sickness, unexpected travel complications such as due to natural disasters) the Association will consider a partial or full refund within three days

If the contract was concluded by the distant means of communication (either online or by phone) the consumer can withdraw from the contract within fourteen days of conclusion of the contract. Withdrawing from the contract is not possible after completing the participation of the activities.

CLOSING STATEMENT

By registering for Activities organised by the Association, the Participant confirms that she/he is familiar with these Terms and Conditions and that she/he fully agrees with them in their entirety.

The Association is obliged to present the content of these Terms and Conditions to all the Participants participating in the Activities.

The Association reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions any time, so please review them frequently. Changes and clarifications will take effect immediately upon their posting on the website. If we make material changes to these Terms and Conditions, we will notify you here that it has been updated, so that you are aware of the changes.
