

ABOUT US

The International Association of Bleausardes (L'association Internationale Des Bleausardes registered in France with the number W774006209, referred to below as "we", "us" or "the Association") is a not-for-profit voluntary organisation.

Our goals, as stated in the official Status (available in French upon request), are as follows:

- To promote gender equality in the climbing community
- To encourage climbers who identify as female to develop their outdoor climbing skills
- To aid the conservation of the Fontainebleau Forest
- To organize social gatherings serving our other goals
- To facilitate mentorship relationships between climbers of various levels and ages
- To provide formal and informal instruction in sports such as the climbing, parkour and yoga
- To encourage experienced climbers to share their knowledge with the community and facilitate knowledge sharing through mentorship
- To facilitate cooperation between climbers and the governing bodies responsible for the protection of the Fontainebleau Forest

PRIVACY POLICY

This Policy details the way in which we store and process your data, as well as your rights and options regarding accessing and managing your data stored by us.

Please read this Policy carefully. We invite you to contact us in case of any questions.

The provision of your personal information to us is voluntary but without your personal information, such as name and contact details, we will not be able to deliver our services to their full capacity. For example, we will not be able to send you additional details regarding the schedule of the Women's Bouldering Festival, or in advance provide you with our consent form.

1. HOW WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 You can submit your personal information to us in a number of ways:
 - a) In person, in writing (by email or otherwise) or by word of mouth
 - b) Using a MailChimp subscription form on our website
 - c) Registering for one of our three events (Route-Setting Workshop, Women's Bouldering Festival and Fontainebleau Forest Conservation Workshop) via Eventbrite
- 1.2 If your personal information is available publicly (for example, via social media), we might use it to contact you but after initially contacting you, will not continue to store it, process it, or use it to contact you without your consent.
- 1.3 Our website is hosted on the Wix.com platform which may securely store your data collected through cookies. Please refer to the USE OF COOKIES notice below this Policy for further information.

2. SPECIAL DATA CATEGORIES

The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) categorises certain categories of personal data as sensitive and requiring special protection. For our purposes, these may include information about your health and religious beliefs. If necessary and provided by you, we may collect and use these special categories of data to ensure your safety and that your rights are not violated. We will only collect and process these special categories of data if there is a specific reason for doing so.

3. HOW YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS USED (PROCESSING PURPOSES) We only use your personal information for the purposes of running the events we organise (Route-Setting Workshop, Women's Bouldering Festival and Fontainebleau Forest Conservation Workshop) and in accordance with the goals outlined in the About Us section above this Policy.

Your data is used to:

- a) register you to an event
- b) to maintain your accurate contact information
- c) to send you our newsletter and to provide you with further information about our activities
- d) to answer your queries
- e) to ensure your safety during our events

4. MARKETING PURPOSES

We may use your contact details that you have provided to us to send you information about our or our partners' activities we believe may be of interest to you.

We will only do this via email and not without your prior consent. You can always opt out from receiving marketing related communication by following the unsubscribe link in our newsletter or contacting us directly at womensbouldering@qmail.com.

5. WHO DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION WITH We will never pass on your personal data to any third parties without your explicit consent.

However, in order to provide our services, we rely on a number of third party data processors. These are: wix.com, MailChimp and Eventbrite.

6. LAWFUL BASES

The GDPR requires us to rely on one or more lawful bases to use your personal information. We consider the grounds listed below to be relevant:

- a) Consent when you have given us explicit consent to store and process your data
- b) Necessity to fulfil a contract (for example, provide you with details necessary to access one of our events you registered for)

7. OUR COMMITMENT TO SECURITY

We are committed to keeping your personal information safe and secure and we only use recognisable and trustworthy data processors to store and process your data (wix.com, MailChimp, Eventbrite).

Your personal information is only accessible by the Association's management staff and stored on secure servers which have features to prevent unauthorised access.

8. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

GDPR applies to all countries within the European Economic Area ("EEA") and those countries are therefore subjected to the same level of data protection law. We do not perform any operations outside of the EEA and will not pass your data to any third countries outside of EEA.

Please note that companies which platforms we use (wix.com, MailChimp and Eventbrite) are data processors based outside of the EEA. They are however committed to enabling GDPR compliance.

9. YOUR RIGHTS

We rely on your consent to use your personal data and you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. You can unsubscribe from our mailing list, or request a complete deletion of your data from our databases (right of erasure).

You can access (right of access) and request a copy of the personal information we store about you at any time. You can be issued with a copy of your data in a machine-readable format (right of portability). Upon your request, your personal data will be checked and updated (right of rectification). On legitimate grounds you, you can object to your data being stored and processed (right of objection).

You are further entitled to make a complaint to the <u>National Commission on Informatics and Liberty</u> (CNIL).

USE OF COOKIES

The Association's website is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to provide our services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.
